What are the requirements and benefits of being a tutor?

- ✓ Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older.
 - ✓ Tutor children for 1 hour each week.
- ✓ A minimum of 1 academic year commitment required.
 - ✓ Work 1-on-1 with a child.
- ✓ Meet monthly with other volunteers to learn, share, and brainstorm ways to best help young learners.
- ✓ Volunteer hours will be after school, in the evenings and/or weekends.
 - ✓ Great opportunity for community hours.
